
ROCKY POINT MEXICO OUTING

GREAT BASIN NATIONAL PARK, NEVADA

This national park has 77,000 acres and an altitude that ranges from 6,000 to 13,000 feet.

Some of the things it's noted for is:

Wheeler Peak at over 13,00 feet

The Lehman Caves complex

Old growth bristlecone pine trees

Really dark night skies

Beautiful high mountain lakes and hiking trails.

Diverse plant life due to the wide elevation changes.(Altitudinal Zonation)

DON'T BLOW YOUR BREAKERS

DON'T ACCIDENTALLY TRIP YOUR BREAKERS OR THE RV PARKS BY KNOWING HOW MUCH POWER YOU ARE PULLING

Below is a chart of typical power drains for different things in your RV or trailer.

1Air Conditioner (1500 BTU)	12.2 amps
2Electric Water Heater	12.5 amps
3Refrigerator	7.0 amps
4Microwave Oven	12.5 amps
5Toaster Ovens	10.4 amps
6Electric Coffee Pot	9.0 amps

As you can see the amps add up pretty quickly. If you don't know the amp rating of an appliance but you know the wattage, just divide the watts by 120(the voltage supplied) and that will give you the amps.
