
Dolores River RV Park September 11-16, 2024

Check Your Tires!

During our last couple RV trips, I noticed a vibration in the steering wheel of our motorhome whenever our speed was slowed down to between 30-40 mph. I thought possibly we had lost a balance weight off one of our front tires although nothing was obvious when looking at the tires.
