Annual Meeting costs have included room rental, and breakfast costs for omelets. Suggestions were to cut the breakfast to coffee and donuts. Ray has negotiated room rental to N/C this time. It's possible that the RV Park will prepare us a steak dinner @ \$15 per person. Ray will confirm with the park. This would be paid by each person ordering a steak dinner and prepared by the RV park staff. Blue Compass is cutting costs and we do not expect them to participate at the annual meeting.

Christmas party. The Christmas committee will make decisions as to location, cost or no cost, and increase each attendee's portion accordingly.
